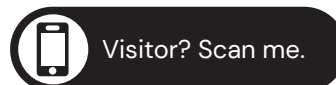

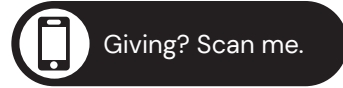

The Apostle's Creed

People: I believe in God, the Father Almighty,
the Maker of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord:
Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, dead, and buried;

He descended into hell.

The third day he rose again from the dead;

He ascended into heaven,
And sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty;
From thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit;
the holy catholic church;
the communion of saints;
the forgiveness of sins;

The Apostles' Creed is one of the oldest universally agreed upon statements of Christian faith outside of scripture, from the first few centuries of the church. It is not in addition to scripture, but rather a summary of doctrines which are clear in scripture. It was used for baptismal candidates in the early church. *In this context, "catholic" means "universal": the church in all places at all times.
