



The Sermon

"Following Jesus By Remembering"

Deuteronomy 8:11-18

I. You need a Theology of Moving

1. God made us for home here with Him, but we lost it. Returning home begins with Jesus who is restoring what we lost.

2. God sends His people out, moving them so that the world would be blessed, and home eventually restored.

3. Our world is broken, and so God advances this movement through our suffering.

4. God is on the move in our world, and calls us to go with Him. We cannot stay where we are and go with God.

5. Wherever God places us, He calls us to put down roots, and seek the good of the city. As resident aliens, we show mercy and seek the common good.

6. Following God means following Jesus, no matter the cost. Moving with Jesus will cost you.

7. The most significant work to which Jesus calls us is gathering people by making disciples who make disciples.

8. Jesus calls us to move together, united as one people of God.

9. The Resurrection of Jesus changes the story. We move with confidence because our future home here is guaranteed.

10. We have not arrived until God fully restores home. Knowing this, we remember God's movement in the world.

*In this context, "catholic" means "universal": the church in all places at all times.
