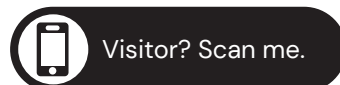

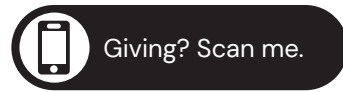
## Psalm 16

*\*In this context, "catholic" means "universal": the church in all places at all times.*
